HOW TO REACH PAMPLONA

Pamplona is located in the region of Navarra, at the west side of the Spanish border with France. You can reach the city by different means:

1) BY PLANE

- Pamplona Airport

The small airport of Pamplona can be reached via Madrid with [Iberia](#).

Once at the airport, the only way to reach the city is by taxi, but the distance to the city is very short. A typical journey to or from the airport to the city centre costs between €15 and €20.

- Other nearby airports

[Bilbao airport](#) and [Zaragoza airport](#) have international flights and they are 2 hours driving from Pamplona. Renting a car is the best way to reach Pamplona from these airports, although there are also regular buses from these cities to Pamplona, but may not be suitable depending on arrival/departure timings.

[Vitoria airport](#) (Ryanair) and [San Sebastián airport](#) are located at 1 hour driving distance from Pamplona. Renting a car is the best way to reach Pamplona from these airports, although there are also regular buses from these cities to Pamplona, but may not be suitable depending on arrival/departure timings.

Another option is the [Biarritz airport](#), in southern France, at 1.5h driving from Pamplona. In case of arrival to Biarritz, renting a car to reach Pamplona is recommended. Take into account that if you rent a car in France, you will not be able to give it back in Spain, so you will have to keep the car until your flight back.

2) BY TRAIN

Coming from the North, the nearest international connection is Hendaye, in the south of France. Hendaye is at 1.5 h driving from Pamplona, and renting a car is the best option (the connection by train to Pamplona is not recommended).

An alternative is to fly into international airports such as Madrid and Barcelona and then take the train to Pamplona. The journey takes about 3.5 hours from Madrid and 4 hours from Barcelona, but you have to add the time it takes to get from the airports to the train stations, which are in the centre of the cities.
